 - e. You shall not consume any alcohol or be found in any establishment where alcohol is sold and consumed.
 - f. Avoid contact with and/or use of marijuana, dangerous drugs, or narcotics, except those prescribed by a physician or dentist; and submit to urinalysis, chemical testing, and/or Breathalyzers as required by the Probation Officer.
 - g. Support my dependents, pay my fines and debts, and not assume additional financial obligations without prior approval of the Probation Officer.
 - h. Immediately inform the Probation Officer when I have <u>ANY</u> contact with law enforcement.
 - i. Participate in medical/mental/vocational/educational/ drug and alcohol treatment or training programs as directed by the Probation Officer, sign the agencies' release of information form for documentation of my attendance and progress, and not terminate such treatment without the prior approval of the Probation Officer.
 - j. Submit my person and property to search and seizure at any time when so requested by a Probation Officer, with or without probable cause. Subject to random home visits while on probation, with or without probable cause.
